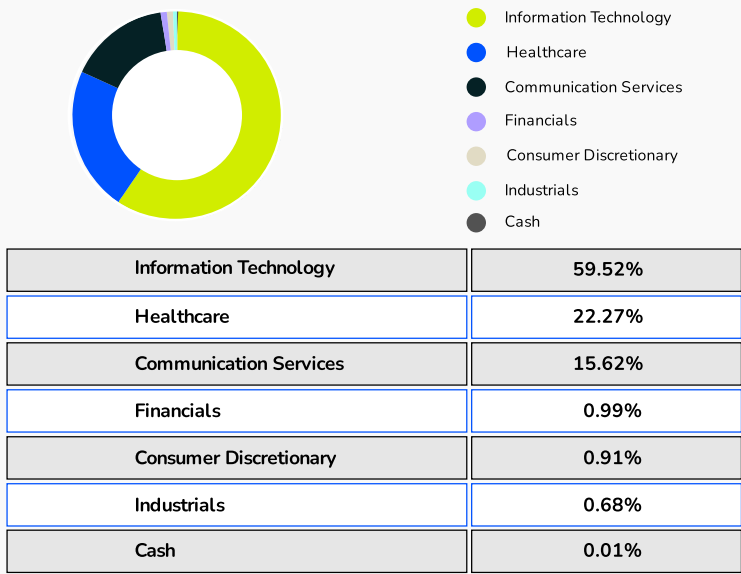

The Nasdaq US Large Cap Select Disruptors™ Index utilizes a proprietary, quantitative methodology developed by Nasdaq, Inc designed to identify companies that have high “Disruptor Scores”. The top 50 companies identified are then included in the index selection.

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The Fund is passively-managed and attempts to mirror the composition and performance of the Index. The Fund’s returns may diverge from that of the Index due to costs and expenses incurred by the Fund or its holdings may deviate from a precise correlation with the Index. The Index uses proprietary methodology to select securities and there can be no assurance this will result in positive performance. The S&P 500 is a market-capitalization-weighted index of 500 of the largest U.S. publicly traded companies. The index is widely regarded as a benchmark for large cap U.S. equity performance. Distribution Rate represents a single distribution from the fund and does not represent total return to the fund. The distribution rate is calculated by annualizing the most recent distribution and dividing it by the most recent NAV.

30-Day SEC Yield is a standard yield calculation developed by the Securities and Exchange Commission that allows for fairer comparisons among bond funds. It is based on the most recent month end. This figure reflects the interest earned during the period after deducting the Fund's expenses for the period.
